









Finland's participation in the EU's [2006, %] Figure 20. rapid response force




"If Finland were attacked, should Finns, in your opinion, take up arms to defend themselves in all situations, even if the outcome seemed uncertain?"

"If Finland were attacked, should Finns, in your opinion, take up arms to defend themselves in all situations, even if the outcome seemed uncertain?"







"Considering the present world situation as a whole, do you believe that during the next five years Finland and Finns will live in a world which is more secure or less secure than the present?"




Confidence in the future [1990-2006, %]

"Considering the present world situation as a whole, do you believe that during the next five years Finland and Finns will live in a world which is more secure or less secure than the present?"



"How do you assess the following phenomena and factors? How do they affect the security of Finland and Finns?"







"How do you estimate the following phenomena and factors? How much do they concern you regarding the future?"




